The Chilcot report is a damning indictment of Tony Blair and those around him who took us to war in Iraq. The report vindicates Stop the War and all we have been campaigning for over the years. There must be legal sanctions against Tony Blair and he should no longer be considered fit for any office.

Cameron says we must "learn the lessons" but continues the same spin as Tony Blair. In fact he and his government should be held to account. In 2011 Cameron bombed Libya openly supporting "rebels" to overthrow the Libyan government and supported foreign funded and backed "rebels" to bring about regime change in Syria. Britain has continued to intervene militarily in Syria. Iraq, Libya, Yemen, and in many other countries in one way or another. Now the British government is cynically continuing its war preparations in Europe. NATO wants to establish "a new force in Europe" specifically targeting Russia placing NATO forces on its borders.

The anti-war movement demands that the Chilcot publication leads to justice for all those killed in Iraq. We also call for an anti-war government that ends the cycle of wars and violence by Britain's interference in other countries throughout the world.
