### No More Blood for Oil Bring the Troops Home

Yet more revelations exposing the brutality of an illegal occupation have followed tragic news of the 101st British Soldier killed in Iraq. Millions are now saying that there has been enough carnage - over 2,000 US soldiers have been killed and 18,000 wounded and an estimated 100,000 innocent civilians. Hundreds of British soldiers have also been seriously wounded.

Recent elections in Iraq have done nothing to introduce real democracy into a country which is moving towards fragmentation. The shocking evidence of the use of white phosphorous in Fallujah and the use of napalm type weapons elsewhere eventually found its way into the mainstream media as did news that US companies stand to make \$200 billion once they control the oil - vindicating what many said were the real reason's for George Bush's 'war for oil'.

Millions of people in Britain are appaled at the carnage as Blair's government commits 4,000 more troops to Afghanistan ... and there is an increasing threat to Iran echo the build up to the attack on Iraq. Crude generalisations about Muslims and racist Islamophobia are the background to the drumbeat of impending war.
