Over the last 10 years the stop the war movement has opposed successive wars launched by successive British Government's since the invasion of Afghanistan in October 2001. Following the attack on the twin towers in New York in September 2001 Bush and Blair launched their "war on terror" using it as an excuse to use their weapons of mass destruction against populations and cities of Afghanistan, Iraq and occupying these countries causing the death of hundreds of thousands of people including the thousands of soldiers sent to kill and be

killed from the US, Britain and other countries. The occupation of Afghanistan continues after 10 years as the longest foreign intervention war of the big powers in modern times. Now with the interference of Britain and other NATO powers in Libya yet another sovereign country has been bombed and plunged into chaos killing many thousands people so far in over 20,000 bombing raids. The bombing of Libya and the destruction of one of the most modern countries in Africa with one of the highest living standards, a member of the African union, has been subject to such a war by the NATO powers for their strategic interests in recolonising Africa and control of Libya's resources. Bush and Blair launched their wars for conquest of the Middle East and now Obama and Cameron are extending theses wars into Africa.

The discussion forum is being held to mark this anniversary of the stop the war movement of opposing Britain's pro-war governments and to to sum up this historic work.

In marking this anniversary we will also look toward the next 10 years of the anti-war movement with the aim to further build the movement to end these crimes against peace and to bring about an anti-war government in Britain. A government that stands for:

- The peaceful resolution of international conflicts.
- Bringing all troops home from foreign soil.
- Withdrawing Britain from NATO.
